Bishops Conference elects Archbishop Costelloe president Congratulations Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SDB on being elected the next president of the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference! Archbishop Costelloe is the first president from Western Australia and the first member of a religious order to be elected president. The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has also re-elected Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP as vice-president. Archbishop Costelloe will replace Archbishop Mark Coleridge, who served as president for four years. Archbishop Coleridge was ineligible to run for a third term because he will turn 75 in September 2023.

8th May 2022 marks the 59th Anniversary of the *World Day of Prayer for Vocations*. The Holy Mother Church takes this day to publicly fulfill the Lord's command to "ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). As much as we try our best to promote the culture of vocations within our family, parish community, and archdiocese; we ultimately affirm the primacy of grace and faith that only God can send good and faithful labourers into his harvest. We appreciate all forms of vocations, highlighting God's unique call to each one of us and our individual response to that call.
