## Feast Days of the Week: St. James, apostle July 25



Son of Zebedee and Salome, brother of Saint John the Apostle, and may have been Jesus' cousin. St. James, known as the Greater, in order to distinguish him from the other Apostle St. James, our Lord's cousin, was St. John's brother. With Peter and John he was one of the witnesses of the Transfiguration, as later he was also of the agony in the garden. He left everything when Christ called him to be a fisher of men. Was present during most of the recorded miracles of Christ. Preached in Samaria, Judea, and Spain. First Apostle to be martyred. He was beheaded in Jerusalem in 42 or 43 on the orders of Herod Agrippa.

## St. Christopher July 25

The name "Christopher" means Christ-bearer, and may allude to the legend of the man carrying the Christ Child across the river. Saint Christopher also did not become popularized in the Church until the 7th century, about three centuries after his supposed death. St. Christopher is the patron saint of travelers and of children.



## Saints Joachim and Anne: July 26



Saints Joachim and Anne, are the parents of the Virgin Mary. Mary had good, faithful parents who raised her with a love and devotion to God like none other except Jesus Christ Himself. Joachim and Anne serve as role models for parents and both deserve to be honoured and emulated for their devotion to God and Our Lady Mary, the Mother of God.
