Revised Bulletin Format

Welcome to the new, larger format Bulletin.

Archbishop Costelloe, in 2015, put forward his vision for the church in Perth - "Return the Church to Christ, and Return Christ to the Church". He released 'The Way Forward', a plan to focus our minds the key priorities, one of which was Strengthening and Revitalising Parishes. A group was formed and developed an updated Constitution for Parish Pastoral Councils, released in July last year.

The St Aloysius Council reflected on what this could mean for our community, and in October they chose three areas to work on: Communication, Evangelisation and Youth.

Communication was seen as some way to share with parishioners what is happening in the parish, a calendar of classes for faith development, and steps we could take beyond Sunday Mass which would bring us closer to Christ.

A first step was to expand the Bulletin and use the extra room to go deeper. You will find messages from our shepherds, the Pope and the Archbishop. You will be invited to increase your spiritual life and your knowledge of the treasures of our Faith. You will be informed on what is happening in our Church, locally and globally.

Secondly, can you make a point to take the Bulletin home every week and talk about it with your family. Thirdly, can you please, please give feedback and comments on what you value and what you don't. Fourthly, consider dropping a note with your thoughts and hopes for inclusion in the Bulletin.

TOWNSVILLE BISHOP: THIS IS A TIME TO RALLY TOGETHER After years of failed wet seasons and living under the mythical rain-free "dome", Townsville has experienced a catastrophic rain event since last week. Townsville Bishop Tim Harris was himself caught in the middle of the flooding disaster, having to evacuate as a precaution. He said the scale of the flooding was something he had never experienced before. Bishop Harris has been heartened by the strength of the community. "To see the streets full of SES volunteers, Queensland Fire and Emergency Service, police and army personnel roaming the streets offering assistance with evacuations and sandbagging was amazing," he said. "This is not a time to throw in the towel or give up. It is a time to rally together and, as a people of faith, we have that sense that loss is only temporary and out of death comes life. We can't be conquered and we are saved by faith in the resurrection." *Full report at www.cathnews.com*

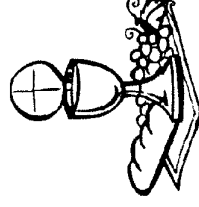

Pope's historic visit to Arabian peninsula: Pope Francis has held the first Papal Mass at a stadium in Abu Dhabi, the first time the pontiff visited the Arabian Peninsula. About 135,000 Catholics attended the mass on Feb. 5 with some carrying Vatican flags and banners as the pope drove into Zayed Sports City Stadium, where an altar with a large cross was set up for the open-air service.

Pope Francis concluded his visit to the United Arab Emirates on February 5. Preaching to a congregation composed mostly of guest workers, the Pope reflected on the Beatitudes, saying that they "do not require dramatic gestures." He reminded the congregation that Jesus does not say "you will be blessed, but you are blessed."
