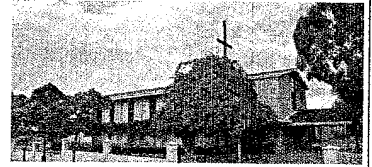




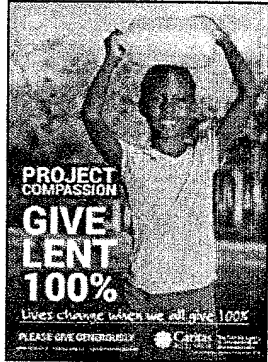

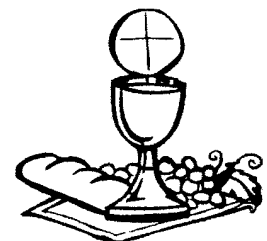

Report in Brief - Council for Australian Catholic Women Colloquium, Adelaide, 22 – 24 February 2019

In a Church in crisis, it was reassuring to attend the Colloquium which featured communion through liturgies and shared stories. I heard clear accounts of great work being done in education and for the poor and needy across Australia. A Plenary 2020 update showed the Australian Catholic Bishops seek wider lay involvement in steering the Church and have applied to Rome to newly include lay representatives with voting rights in the legislative process of Plenary 2020 Council.
