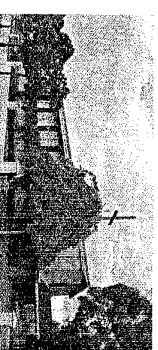

PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

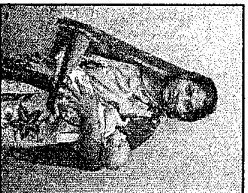

Plenary Council 2020 – Phase Two. Listening and Discernment

Archbishop Costelloe SDB, President of the Plenary Council 2020, has expressed the amazement of the Australian bishops to the fantastic response and prayerful engagement of so many. 220,000 people have been directly or in groups contributing over 17,000 submissions as the input for the Council agenda. Expert analysts have begun sorting through the submissions, drawing out common threads. This is the Listening and Discernment. Key threads will be worked up and put out for further comments. Thank you to all St Aloysius' parishioners who played their part.

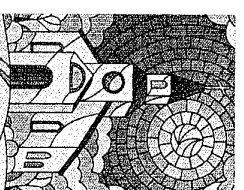
