**St Aloysius Lenten Reflection Group: Thurs., 28 March, 7.00 - 8.15pm**

In Week 4, the familiar Parable of the Prodigal Son in Luke's Gospel is about Reconciling. It is an apt theme at this discordant point in Pope Francis's papacy when he reaches out to the marginalised and, if they return home, welcomes them in the name of mercy and compassion. Many seem to believe, as the 'good son' in the parable did, that making allowances is unwarranted. What is your position? All are welcome to join our discussion.
