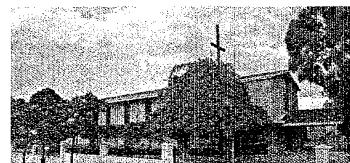

As Christians, however, we know the cross is not the end, but rather the beginning of a glorious new journey of love, hope and salvation.

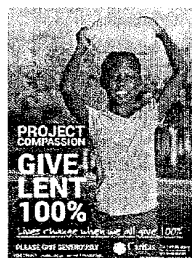

**Good Friday Collection:** The annual collection for the support of the church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in Holy Land by providing welfare assistance to the local Christians in the areas such as health, education, employment and housing. The collection is also used to maintain over 70 churches and shrines associated with the life of Jesus. Last year, Australian Catholics donated \$1.4 million to this cause. Please also pray that peace and harmony will become a reality in the birth place of Jesus.

### Plenary Council 2020 – Phase Two. Listening and Discernment

Archbishop Costelloe SDB, President of the Plenary Council 2020, has expressed the amazement of the Australian bishops to the fantastic response and prayerful engagement of so many. 220,000 people have been directly or in groups contributing over 17,000 submissions as the input for the Council agenda. Expert analysts have begun sorting through the submissions, drawing out common threads. This is the Listening and Discernment. Key threads will be worked up and put out for further comments. 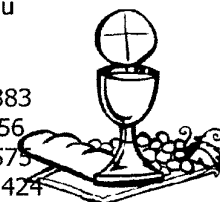
