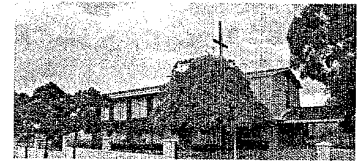

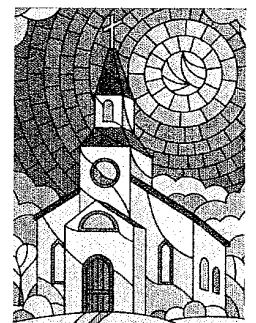

### Changes are coming

In March this year, Pope Francis completed five years on the throne of Peter. He has elected with the expectation that he would review the functioning of the church, focussing on the Roman Curia, and regularising the church's finances. He has laboured tirelessly to re-orient the church towards the message of Jesus, Christ, a loving person who preached Compassion and Mercy, particularly for the isolated and oppressed. A church facing outwards to walk with the marginalised and no longer concentrating on building walls to exclude the 'unworthy'.



His signature document for his papacy was his letter "Joy of the Gospel" (*Evangelii Gaudium*) of November 2013. In this, he calls to Christians that 'the centre of all evangelising activity and all efforts at Church renewal' start with the fundamental, the First Proclamation (in Greek, *Kerygma*) "Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you; and now he is living at your side everyday to enlighten, strengthen and free you",

Pope Francis has steered by this map through the storms of the sex abuse catastrophe, the steady opposition to his teaching and the dogged resistance to any change by many of the Pope's Roman Curia.

Now, after five years of study, reflection and consultation by the Pope's advisory cardinals (the so-called C9), a proposal for renewal of the upper tiers of the Roman church is expected to be shortly released, probably for the Feast of SS Peter and Paul (29 June). Titled *Predicate Evangelium* (Preach the Gospel), the changes will

- Emphasise the primacy of being a Missionary church, reaching out to all on earth with the *Kerygma* – the First Proclamation – through structural changes in the Curia
- Provide greater opportunity for participation in church governance by lay people, both women and men
- Highlight the importance and independence of all bishops, whom the Curia is to assist and not to inform

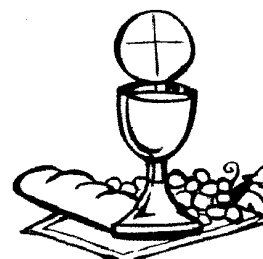
