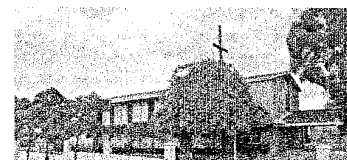

## Lenten Devotions

During Lent, the *Divine Mercy Chaplet* will be recited before Mass Monday to Thursday at 7.40am. On each Friday, the *Stations of the Cross* will be held at 7.30am, followed by Mass at 8.00am. Lent: This is a time of Review, Renewal and Growth. A time for Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving, fasting on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. We focus not on 'what we can give up' but on 'what we can take up'. What extra can we undertake which leads to growth in our nearness to Christ, in our concern with Christ in others. It could be a rosary, daily Mass, adoration, or attending one of the courses, retreats or conversations as offered in the Panorama list of events, in the Church foyer.
