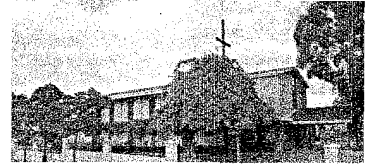




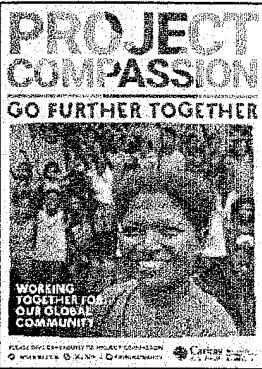

TEMPORARY MASS CHANGES – NOVEL CARONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

On Wednesday 4 March 2020, Bishop Sproxtton, as Administrator of the Archdiocese of Perth (in the absence of Archbishop Costelloe), issued a directive of temporary changes that are to be applied across the Archdiocese as preventative measures against the spread of the Coronavirus.

These measures include:

- Holy Water is to be removed from all church entrances.
- The Sign of the Peace is to be omitted at all Masses.
- Communion is only to be distributed under the species of the Sacred Host and you are encouraged to receive the Host in your hand.
- The Precious Blood is not to be shared from the chalice at any Mass and is to be reserved for the celebrant.

These directives have been issued in line with advice issued by the Western Australian and Federal Governments. Copies of the full text Bishop Sproxtton's statement are available in the foyer.

As a follow-on, for the time being, Fr Manoj will not be offering lollies at the end of Mass.

Archbishop's Circular: There are further directives and updates from Archbishop Timothy in his Circular (on Friday 13 March 2020) on the temporary suspension of gatherings of 500 people or more as a result of Novel Coronavirus.

- Commencing on Saturday 21 March 2020, all weekend Masses at St Mary's Cathedral will be temporarily suspended. All weekday Masses at St Mary's will continue.
- Parishioners who feel unwell should not attend Mass, and are excused from their normal obligation.
- Parishioners who feel they may be at risk of infection if they go to Mass should refrain from attending Mass and are excused from their normal obligation.
- Where Masses are suspended, the normal Sunday obligation does not apply unless people are easily able to attend a parish where Mass is celebrated.



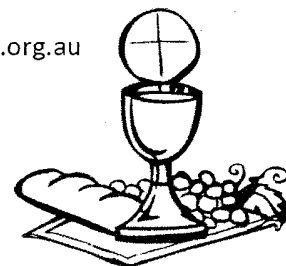
