First Holy Communion Celebration

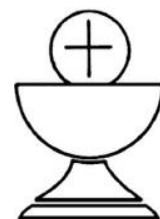
This Sunday is a very special day for our faith community – First Holy Communion Day.

COVID-19 Safety Plan – Phase 4 - St Aloysius Shenton Park

Even though there has been no recent community transmission of Covid19 in W.A., we are still obliged and encouraged to comply with the social distancing rule (1.5 Metres clear from others not in your household). To assist with compliance with this rule, when seated in the church, please ensure that you do not sit either directly in front of or directly behind a person already seated.

Please also remember to:

- Sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the church.
- Sanitise your seat and kneeler with wipes provided before leaving the Church.
- Archbishop Costelloe's directive that you should not attend Mass if you are unwell or have flu/respiratory symptoms.

The WA Government extended the phase 4 restrictions until 24th October 2020. The Office of the Archbishop has advised that the Archbishop Costelloe's directives of 3 Sept shall apply.
