Covid 19 Update In line the further restrictions recently issued by the WA Government and, as endorsed by the Archdiocese, we are required during all indoor church services to:

- Wear a correctly fitted mask at all times;
- Maintain social distancing (1.5m rule) from persons not from your own household;

The 2 square metre rule now applies to determine capacity limits. In general, this rule does not affect us at St Aloysius, the more important rule is the social distancing (1.5m) rule.
