Covid 19 Level 2 Measures - from 3rd March 2022

From 3rd March Level 2 COVID-19 Public Health and Social Measures apply state-wide. The Vicar General, Very Rev Peter Whitely has issued directives for Churches and Chapels within the Archdiocese of Perth, effective from 3rd March 2022. A copy of those directives has been placed on the foyer notice board. So far as our Parish is concerned, many of the directives are currently being implemented. However, we need to re-commence some measures that have been relaxed since those applicable in June 2020: including sanitization of pews and kneelers after Mass, proper attention to the 1.5m social distancing rule whilst seated in pews, going to communion, and leaving the Church after Mass. Lenten Devotions During Lent, the *Divine Mercy Chaplet* will be recited before Mass Monday to Thursday at 7.40am. On each Friday, the *Stations of the Cross* will be held at 7.30am, followed by Mass at 8.00am.

Lenten Reflections The parish has purchased booklets with reflections for each day. These are provided to each household to encourage daily personal meditations in preparation for Easter celebrations. You may pick up your copy from the foyer.


